

The Claredale Champagne Charlie Sires Incentive Scheme



As an inducement to UPWBDA registered Stallion owners to foal record and register all eligible progeny with UPWBDA, and to encourage the owners of visiting mares to do likewise, the idea has been put forward to put up a \$500 cash incentive annually which will be awarded to the owner of the stallion which has the most progeny registered & foal recorded during the preceding breeding year. We have large studs on our books which do not record and register all their eligible foals and do not encourage or ensure that the foals from visiting mares are either.

RULES

1. A \$500 cash incentive bonus shall be awarded to the owner of the UPWBDA Ltd registered DILUTE stallion who has the most progeny registered with the company in any one breeding year (1/8 to 31/7) starting 1/8/04. The minimum number of registered progeny required in any one season for a sire to be eligible will be 5.
2. Progeny may be
 - bred and owned by the stallion owner
 - bred and owned by visiting mare owners
 - bred and sold by the stallion owner
 - bred and sold by visiting mare owners
3. The owner/s of all progeny being registered must be current financial members at the close of the applicable breeding season
4. The stallion owner must be a current financial member
5. All progeny must be either foal recorded or adult registered within the current breeding year and will only be counted towards the total number of progeny for that breeding year ie if registered between 1/8/04 & 31/7/05 will only be counted for that breeding year. Registrations do not accumulate from season to season.
6. The adult registration of a foal recorded horse will be counted as a separate registration (to encourage the continuation of the registration).
7. All registrations must have been finalised in order to be eligible for inclusion i.e. no registrations pending will be eligible.

No nomination fee is envisaged.
